Annual Meeting participants include not only professionals from North America but also from academic and clinical programs all over the world.

They provide a forum to gather and discuss issues on patient education and therapeutic areas, demonstrate new and existing products and provide up-to-date research findings. SPD recognizes that Product Theaters will be promotional and many concentrate on a specific product or drug. These current sessions are not approved for continuing education credits and scheduled at breakfast and lunch during SPD 2025. We encourage companies to utilize high impact / quality speakers for these sessions to maximize attendance. The fee includes meeting space and audio visual. Sponsoring company would pay for lunch expenses. There are four (4) available slots for Product Theaters at SPD 2024, each a maximum of 45 minutes in length:

Rather than filling Product Theater slots "first come, first served", we ask interested companies to prepare a one page summary with their presentation topic, short description and proposed speaker. Product Theater assignments will be made by the SPD's Fundraising Committee, upon approval of topic and speaker by SPD's Executive Committee.

A3. WELCOME RECEPTION \$25,000

Named support of the official "kick off" event of the 2025 meeting to be held Wednesday, July 23. Reception will be promoted as the SPD Welcome Reception, presented by Sponsoring Company.

A4. CLOSING EVENT \$25,000

Named support of the closing event of the 2025 meeting to be held Friday, July 25 at an offsite venue. The event will be promoted as the SPD Closing Event, presented by Sponsoring Company.

A5. ADVISORY BOARD MEETINGS \$25,000 EACH*

The SPD offers Advisory Board meeting slots to companies who wish to meet directly with 10-15 pediatric dermatology thought-leaders to discuss their products and services. The fee for holding an Advisory Board meeting is \$25,000, which includes meeting space. The fee does not include any associated logistical expenses, including audio-visual, honoraria and food & beverage. A6. REGISTRATION BAGS \$12,500

Registrants receive a bag at registration and use it to transport their meeting materials. Sponsor would receive imprint on the bag in conjunction with the SPD's logo and the ability to insert product or literature.

A7. FACULTY DINNER \$10,000

The SPD holds a dinner for all invited meeting speakers as a special thank you for contributing to the success of the program. Event sponsors are able to directly participate, as well as interact and network with speakers and program chairs.

A8. KEYCARDS \$10,000

Company logo would be printed on keycards and provided to attendees upon hotel check in.

A9. EARLY CAREER NETWORKING RECEPTION \$10,000

SPD holds a networking reception for fellows or those out of training for five years or less where they share experiences with other young dermatologists. Supporters receive event signage with their company logo. The event will be promoted as the SPD Early Career Networking Reception, presented by Sponsoring Company.

A10. LITERATURE INSERT \$2,500
